Situated in one of Ireland's most beautiful villages, **Dunmore East Language School** offers something exceptional to students.

OUR PROGRAMME

We run a Junior Summer Programme for a limited number of students aged 11-16 years in July.

Key Features of our programme include:

- Places limited to 30 students
- A stimulating and diverse activity programme
- Host family accommodation
- A special setting in one of Ireland's most beautiful seaside villages
- Airport collection and transfer

Students can join the programme for two or three weeks.



ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Classes take place in bright, purpose built classrooms equipped with multi-media facilities.

Key course elements include:

- 18 hours tuition per week
- Oxford Placement test upon arrival
- Maximum class size of 12 students
- Up-to-date teaching material
- A communicative student-based approach to teaching
- Interactive task-based learning through project work, games and role play
- Weekly progress tests and a detailed final report

Between lessons, students can relax in the spacious grounds of the school.

ACTIVITIES

We offer three programme options: English & Multi-Activities; English & Sailing; English & Horse Riding.

The Multi-Activity programme includes sailing, kayaking, climbing, horse riding, cultural visits and more. For students with special interests, we can add lessons in tennis, golf and horse riding to this option.

Social evenings take place each Thursday allowing students to develop lasting friendships. These events include a pizza night at a local restaurant, Irish dancing and a disco.

On Saturdays students go on full day excursions to Dublin, Cork and Kilkenny.

Sunday is a free day when students relax and share in the life of their host family.



OUR TEAM

School director Charlie Boland M.A (English), PGCE in Education (1st Class Honours) has over 15 years' experience in language teaching having taught in Sicily, Brazil, Spain and Ireland.

Charlie taught for two years at Liceo Europeo in La Moraleja, Madrid. A full time secondary teacher, Charlie has 14 years' experience in the position of Language School Director of Studies.

All of our teachers are university graduates qualified to teach English as a foreign language. All have international experience.

HOST FAMILIES

Staying with a host family is the best way to improve one's English and share in Irish culture.

Our students stay with host families living within the local community with whom we enjoy personal relationships. Our policy is not to place two speakers of the same language in any home.

Student bedrooms must include a desk for study, adequate storage for clothes and a comfortable bed with fresh bed linen provided at least once a week.

DUNMORE EAST & WATERFORD

Dunmore East is the ideal place to study English. Our school is located in the heart of the village, a short walk from the local shops and beaches.

Outside of activity time students can relax and enjoy the green Irish countryside, clean sandy beaches and the security that a small Irish fishing village offers.

Waterford City, the vibrant regional capital of Ireland's Ancient East, is situated just 15km from Dunmore East. The city centre is home to an excellent range of shopping and cultural destinations.

OPTION A: ENGLISH + MULTI-ACTIVITIES

COURSE OVERVIEW

OPTION B: ENGLISH + SAILING

This course combines 18 hours tuition per week with a certified course in sailing.

If you would like to improve your English and enjoy the thrill of taking to the waves, this course is for you. Courses begin on Monday 1st, 8th, 16th and 22nd July. Students may attend for two or three weeks.

ACTIVITIES DETAILS

The sailing element of this course is run in conjunction with Dunmore Adventure, one of Ireland's leading adventure and water sports providers. Certified courses to suit all levels are available.



Key course elements include:

- 10 hours instruction per week in sailing
- Fully qualified & experienced instructors
- The highest safety standards
- All necessary equipment (including wetsuit, buoyancy aid and boats/kayaks)
- Courses recognized by the Irish Sailing Association

At the end of this course students will receive a Certificate of Achievement from the Irish Sailing Association.

Students will also attend one evening activity and one full day excursion each week.

OPTION C: ENGLISH + HORSE RIDING

This course combines 18 hours tuition per week with 3 afternoons of horse riding in the beautiful Irish countryside.

The horse riding element of this course is run in conjunction with Pallas Equestrian Centre www.pallasequestriancentre.ie.

Key course elements include:

- Three afternoons horse riding per week.
- Cross country trails and beach hacks.
- Fully qualified & experienced instructors
- The highest safety standards
- All necessary equipment



Students will also attend two afternoon activities, one evening activity and one full day excursion each week.
